At this time, DOE does not request any additional information but would encourage COGCC to place general language in the permit such that the company would accommodate DOE sampling requests in the future. DOE agrees with the COGCC assessment that the pad is located approximately 2.7 miles from the Rulison site and the bottom-hole-locations range from 2.5 to 3.0 miles from Project Rulison. Accordingly, DOE agrees with COGCC that all wells fall under the Tier 2 sampling and monitoring of the COGCC Rulison Sample and Analysis Plan and are located in Sector 2 of the Rulison SAP. DOE will continue to review the proposed locations and subsurface orientations of the proposed drilling for documentation when sampling occurs. Noble has submitted permits for 16 new wells to be drilled from one new pad NWSW Section 17 7S 94W.

The pad is located approximately 2.7 miles from the Project Rulison well - on fee (private - neither state nor federal) surface.

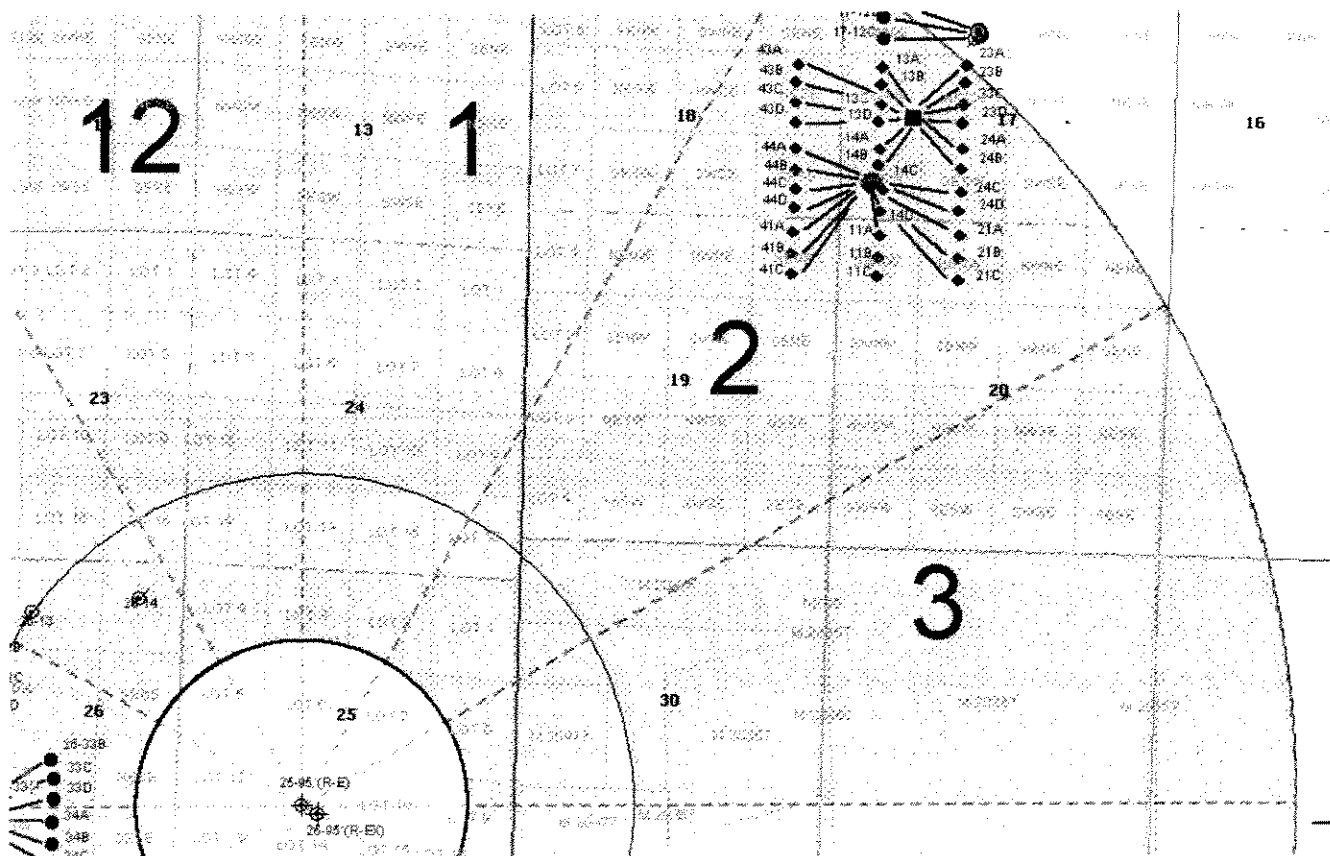
The BHLs are between 2.5 and 3 miles from the Project Rulison well - 10 of the wells are on fee minerals and 6 of the wells are on Federal minerals.

All the wells are in Tier 2, Sector 2 of the Rulison SAP.

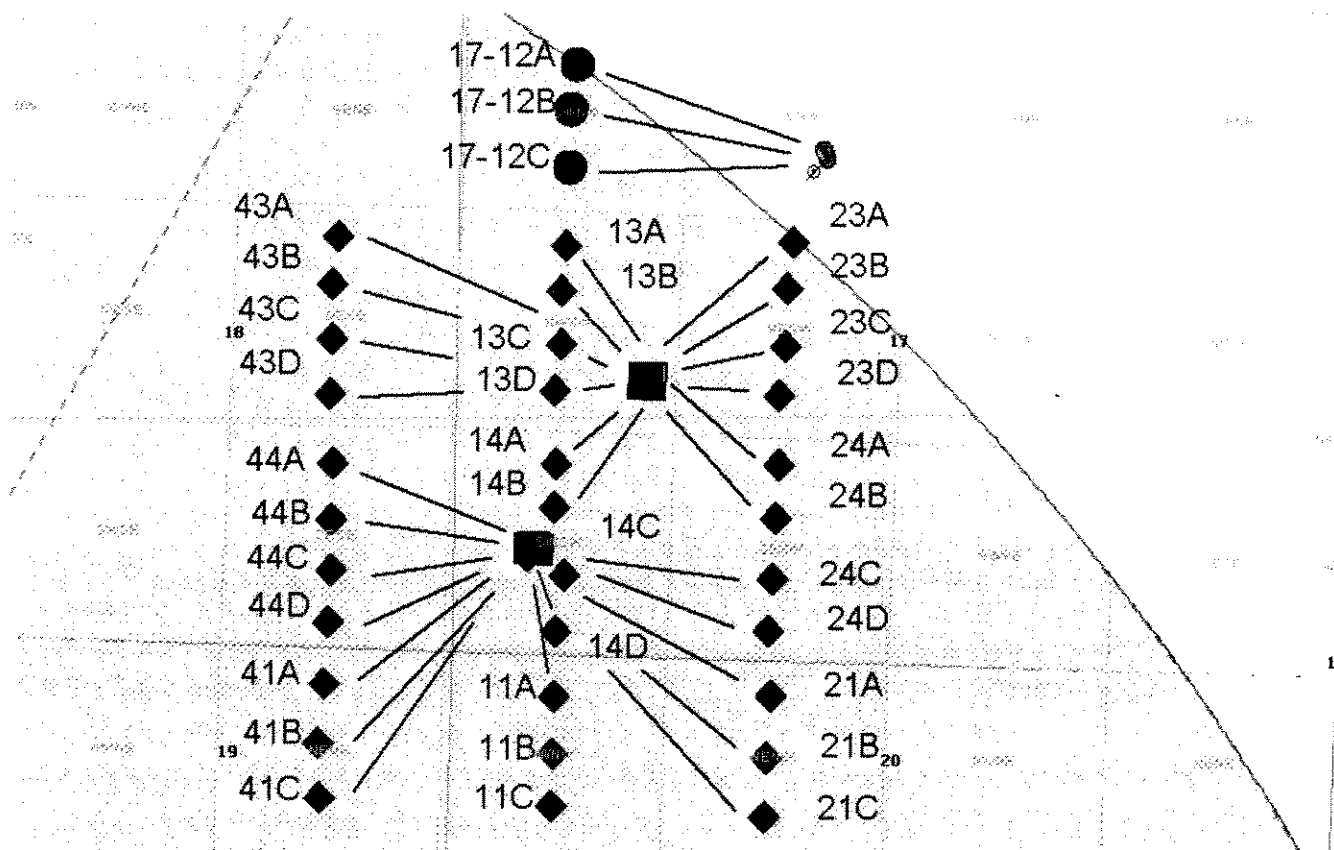
The each permit packet includes a copy of Noble's notification letter to Jack dated June 4, 2009.
