They keep coming – another annoying request for clarification:

1. Section 6. Construction – Since this filed a little while ago, your 2A was slightly different from the most recent version. Please approve me checking the NO box for "is H2S anticipated?"
2. You are correct that the depth to groundwater of 202 feet is from the nearest water well (Permit #159831) located 1395 feet away from the proposed location. However, this water well is completed in a deeper aquifer and is screened from a depth of 224 to 300 feet. This deeper aquifer does not represent the surficial aquifer conditions. There is a shallow well (#18587F) approximately 2960 feet northeast of the proposed location that better represents the depth to groundwater. This shallow well indicates a static water level of 22 feet. Please either provide better data or approve changing the depth to groundwater to 22 feet and adding a comment stating: "The depth to groundwater was based on information from a shallow alluvial water well (Permit #18587F) located 2960 feet from the proposed location."
