Dear Jane, pursuant to our telephone conversation yesterday, please find the location drawing showing no visible improvements within 400' of our BM Federal 14-15 pad. Additionally please find the BM Federal 14-15 1000' radius Hydrology map. This map indicates that there are on streams, rivers, lakes, ponds. Dry washes, etc. located within a 1,000' radius of the proposed well location. Also, we would like you to use the east facing photo as the designated reference area.

The 1,400' referenced in the form 2 was Moffat County Road 129. So that would also be the public road on form 2A. The power lines that run along the road are also 1400' away. The nearest building would be the Robidoux trailer approximately 3500' away, the property line is 623' away and the nearest railroad as far as I can tell is 190,080' away near Hayden Colorado.

If you need us to do anything else to help get this permit through the process please let me know. I look forward to getting your comments. Have a great weekend!!
