The Colorado Division of Wildlife (CDOW) has reviewed the permit application for the above-referenced Oil and Gas Facility located within SWNW 32, Township 2N, Range 68W, Weld County. The proposed location is within an area mapped as bald eagle winter roost, but based on an evaluation by the district wildlife manager, the drilling activity should have minimal impact on this sensitive wildlife habitat. In conversation between you and Celia Greenman on September 25, you indicated that there would be no open pits left on site, and that fluids would be stored in closed tanks. With no further concerns, we do not feel that an on-site consultation is necessary for this well.
