Jubal,

I have been reviewing the Battle Mountain Federal 14-95 (#1637147) **Form 2A**. COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data New Frontier has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment.

1. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates that the distance to the nearest water well is 4300 feet with a depth to groundwater of 295 feet bgs. COGCC review indicates that this is the nearest water well (Permit No. 127035-Rubidoux); however, I was not able to confirm the depth to groundwater from the state database information. I did find water levels in two other nearby wells; Permit No. 213539-A-Wright, domestic well 5280 feet to the northwest, with a groundwater level of 55 feet bgs, and Permit No. 142618-Douglas, domestic well 2.3 miles to the west, with a groundwater level of 60 feet bgs. If you can confirm the water level in the closest well, we can leave this information; otherwise, I can change the water level information if you send an email with this request.
2. **Rule 303.d.(3).C.:** Neither the scaled Construction Layout Drawing (Figure 2) nor the Location Drawing (Sheet 1) show the location of the proposed/existing water tanks, oil tanks, separator, or gas pipeline. One of these drawings should show the anticipated locations of these new and/or existing facilities.
