On June 1, 2009, a release of approximately 10 barrels of condensate occurred at the abovementioned location. The release resulted from a hole in the bottom of the production tank. The release was contained within the berm area.


As described in the attached Form 19 neither surface water nor groundwater was impacted. Remediation activities commenced on June 4, 2009 and concluded on June 5, 2009. Hydrocarbon field kit analysis for soils assisted in the determination of excavated volumes. Approximately 96 cubic yards of impacted soil were hauled to the Noble Energy landfarm in Weld County.

The attached documentation includes a completed Form 19, Form 27, site map, laboratory analytical results from confirmation soil samples for analysis of TPH, and site diagram showing sample location and results. Based on the site remedial activities and the attached laboratory analytical results, NEI is requesting that the COGCC consider this location remediated, requiring no further action.
