At this time, DOE does not request any additional information but would encourage COGCC to place general language in the permit such that the company would accommodate DOE sampling requests in the future. DOE agrees with the COGCC assessment that the pad is located approximately

2.6 miles from the Rio Blanco site on Federal surface location of SWSW Section 19 3S 97W. Three of the wells (8803D-30, 8806D-30, and 8809D-25) will have bottom hole locations of approximately 3.1-3.2 miles outside the three-mile notification zone. The bottom-hole-locations for the five remaining wells within the three-mile notification zone range from approximately 1.7 to 2.7 miles from the Rio Blanco site. DOE will continue to review the proposed locations and subsurface orientations of the proposed drilling for documentation when sampling occurs. Encana has submitted permits for a new pad within the Project Rio Blanco 3 mile radius.

The pad location is in the SWSW Section 19 3S 97W.

They have submitted 8 permits – 5 for wells within the Project Rio Blanco 3 mile radius and 3 for wells outside the Project Rio Blanco 3 mile radius.

The pad is on Federal Surface and all the wells are on Federal Minerals, and within the Federal Exploration Eureka Unit.

The pad is approximately 2.6 miles from the project well.

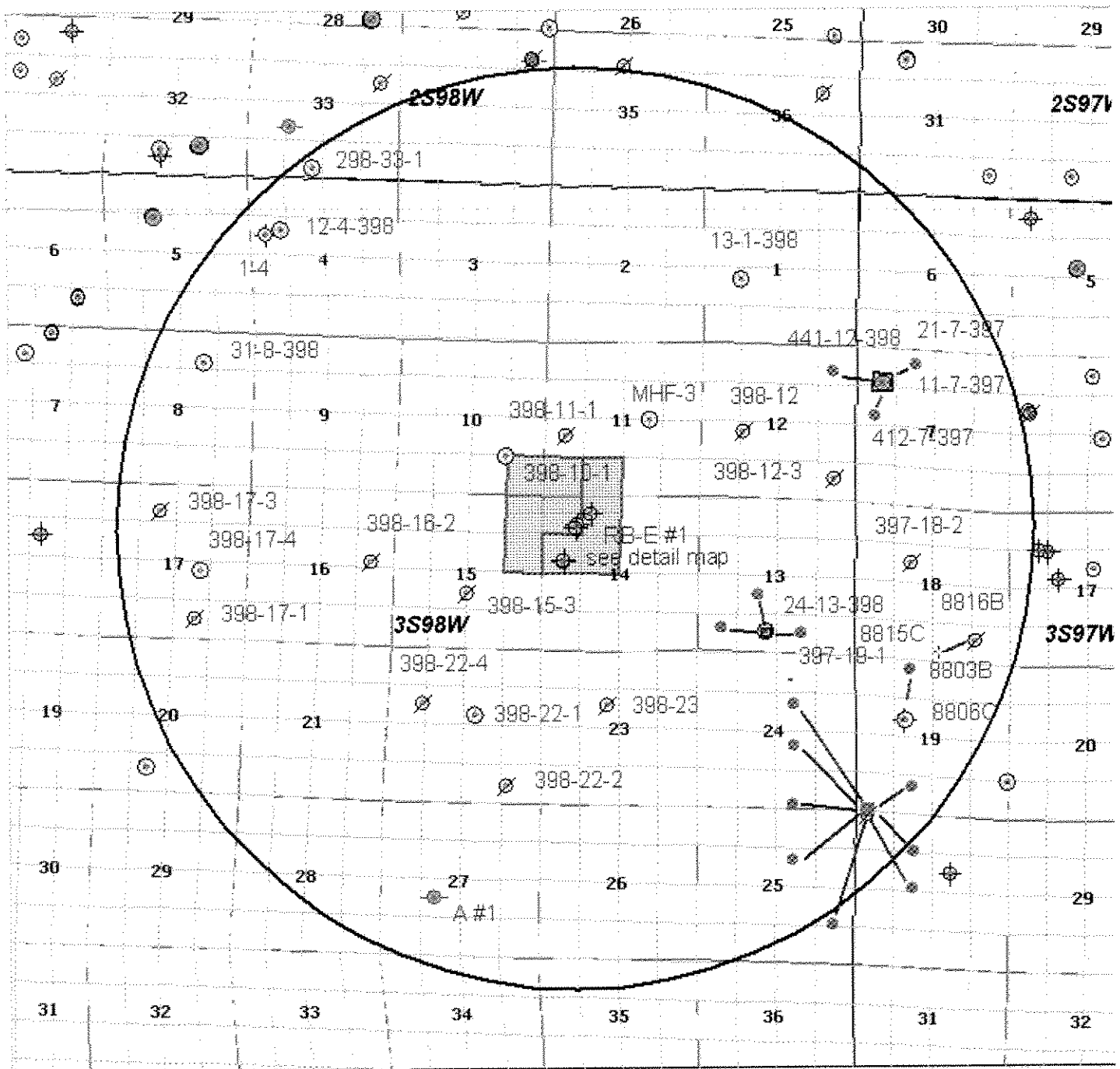
The bottom hole locations for the 5 wells within the 3 mile radius are between approximately 1.7 and 2.7 miles from the project well.

The bottom hole locations for the 3 wells outside the 3 mile radius are between approximately 3.1 and 3.2 miles from the project well.

The well list spreadsheet and a more detailed map are attached.

Encana's permits have a letter to Jack dated October 23, 2009.
