Georgina,

I have been reviewing the Nataly Federal 21-18 (#400014584) **Form 2A**. COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data Pioneer has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment.

1. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the depth to groundwater to be 80 feet bgs for a well located 4258 feet from the proposed pad. COGCC's review indicates there is a water well (Permit No. 153905-Taylor, domestic/stock well) to the east-northeast, with a total depth of 80 feet bgs, a depth to groundwater of 19 feet bgs, and a pumping rate of 40 gpm. I believe this is the well you located; however this well is screened in the shallow alluvial aquifer adjacent to the stream, and therefore, is not indicative of the conditions near the proposed well. Another water well (Permit No. 217562-Terry, domestic well) located 9926 feet to the west-southwest, with a total depth of 320 feet bgs, a depth to groundwater of 153 feet bgs, and a pumping rate of 1.5 gpm, is more indicative of the groundwater conditions at the proposed well. I can make the change if you send me an email with this request.
