Location is in a sensitive area because of close proximity to a domestic water well, close proximity to surface water, and shallow GW; therefore, operator must ensure 110 percent secondary containment for any volume of fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations.

Location is in a sensitive area because of proximity to a domestic water well; therefore production pits must be lined.

Operator must implement best management practices to contain any unintentional release of fluids.

Location is in a sensitive area because of proximity to a domestic water well; therefore either a lined drilling pit or closed loop system must be implemented.
