DeAnne,

I guess that CDOW is more interested in having EnCana be environmentally responsive and have you do what you need to do in an emergency than us being a watchdog or overly regulatory. Our concern is pretty clear, we would like you to do what you can to schedule your maintenance during the middle of the day, we recognize that there are always things that come up that change schedules and patterns of operations. It is not our intent to hover over oil and gas operations just to say you did not meet the BMP. We do not have the time or inclination to do so. The proposed language already includes in good faith effort and the last sentence as a way to identify your intent for flexibility. We recognize and accept that. I don't think any more "exception clause" language adds anything to the intent of what we are trying to accomplish while at the same time giving you the flexibility to do what you need to do.

Suggested added BMP.

In a good faith effort EnCana or subcontractor will conduct post-development well site visitations between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. and reduce well site

visitations when possible between December 1 and April 15 in mule deer critical winter range and elk winter concentration areas. On the occasion that well conditions are not stabilized we will need to continue working past 4:00 p.m. **This BMP is to exclude fluid movement in order to protect the environment.**

I made a couple of minor changes, they are underlined.
Please let me know if this is acceptable to you.
