Mr. Neslin:

The surface location of Noble Energy Inc's (NEI) proposed well has been staked 145' from an above ground utility line. Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Rule 603.a(1) states that any well drilled must be at least 150' from a major above ground utility. NEI will utilize a drilling rig with the derrick height of 76'. One and one half times that height equals ~~114'~~ <sup>96'</sup>, therefore NEI feels the potential damage to the utility line has been mitigated.

Noble respectfully requests that the COGCC consider the rig height information and approve the statewide setback variance and Application for Permit to Drill the captioned well.
