Mr. Neslin:

The surface location of Noble Energy Inc's (NEI) proposed well has been staked 141' from an above ground utility and a public road. Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) Rule 603.a(1) states that any well drilled must be at one hundred fifty (150) feet or one and one-half ($1 \frac{1}{2}$) times the height of the derrick, whichever is greater, from any building unit, public road, major above ground utility line, or railroad.

The height of the derrick in this matter is 75' tall. One and one-half times the height of the derrick is 112.5'. This ensures the safety of the public and all (NEI) employees while drilling. This variance is necessary to comply with surface owners request (Mr. and Mrs. Wakefield) that this well be drilled where it is staked.

Thank you for your attention in this matter. Noble respectfully requests that the COGCC review the enclosed information and approve the requested variance and Application for Permit to Drill the captioned well.
