Jessica,

I have been reviewing the Horseshoe Canyon 4-28 (#400029084) **Form 2A**. COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data Black Hills has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the depth to groundwater to be 310 feet bgs for a well located 8817 feet from the proposed well pad. COGCC's review did find one water well (Permit No. 270030-Middleton, domestic well) located approximately 9240 feet to the east-northeast; with a total depth of 310 feet bgs, a depth to groundwater of 235 feet bgs, and a pumping rate of 2 gpm. I believe this is the well you located. The number that comes up on our GIS map is 310 feet (this number often pertains to the total depth of the well, not the depth to groundwater). I can make the change if you send me an email with this request.
2. **Rule 303.d.(3).A:** A minimum of four color photographs; one (1) of the staked location from each cardinal direction. Each photograph shall be identified by: date taken, well or location name, and direction of view. There is one picture showing the staked location (northwesterly) and one showing the access road. There needs to be additional photographs in the other three cardinal directions.
3. **Rule 303.d.(3).C.:** Neither the scaled Addendum to Legal Plat for Horseshoe Canyon 4-28 (Sheet 2b of 10) nor the Location Drawing Cut Sheet for Horseshoe Canyon 4-28 (Sheet 3 of 10), show the location of the proposed gas and water pipelines. One of these drawings should show the anticipated locations of these new and/or existing facilities. In addition, there needs to be a scaled drawing showing all visible improvements within 400 feet of the proposed disturbance for the pad.

COGCC would appreciate your concurrence with attaching these COAs to the Form 2A permit prior to passing the OGLA review. The other issues also need to be addressed.
