Ron,

I have been reviewing the Bullseye 22 **Form 2A** (#2589135). COGCC requests the following clarifications regarding the data McElvain Oil & Gas has submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. **Construction (Section 6):** The date for construction (04/01/2010) appears to be incorrect since the construction date has already passed. Can you confirm the estimated drilling/completion schedule and these dates (for the construction date COGCC would like to know approximately when the well will be drilled). I can make the change if you send an email with this request.
2. **Water Resources (Section 14):** Form 2A indicates the distance to the nearest surface is 450 feet. COGCC guidelines require designating all locations within close proximity to surface water (i.e., less than 500 feet) a **sensitive area**. The following conditions of approval (COAs) will apply:
COA 4 - Location is in a sensitive area because of proximity to surface water; therefore, operator must ensure 110 percent secondary containment for any volume of fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations.
COA 5 - Operator must implement best management practices to contain any unintentional release of fluids.

COGCC would appreciate your concurrence with attaching these COAs to the Form 2A permit prior to passing the OGLA review. The other issue also needs to be addressed prior to permit approval.
