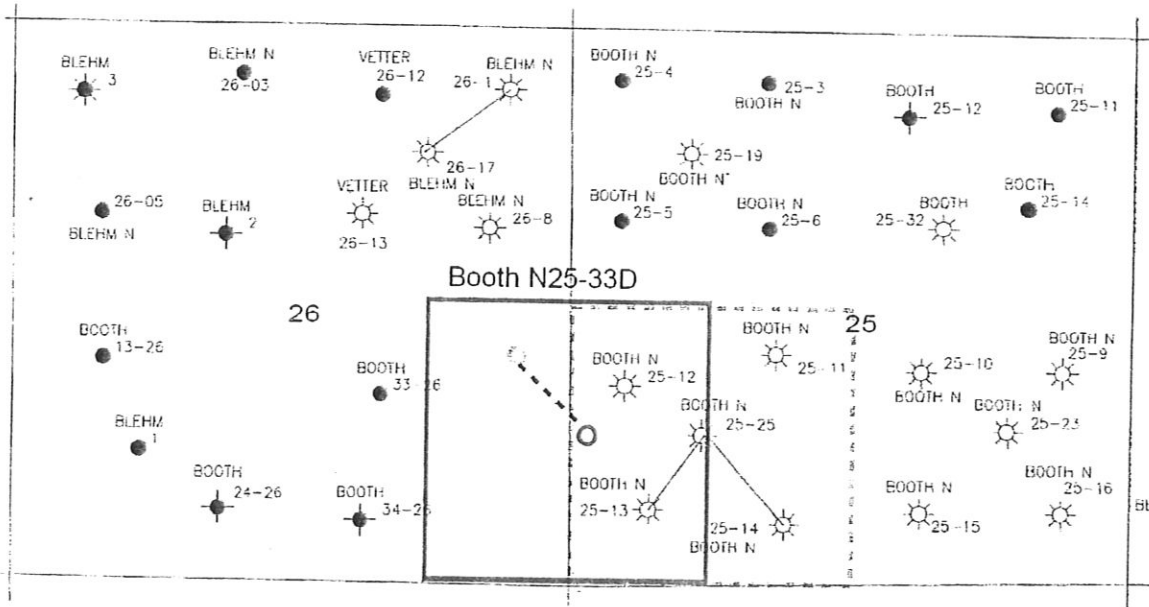

Bottom Hole Located SWSW, Section 25, T5N, R67W, 6th PM

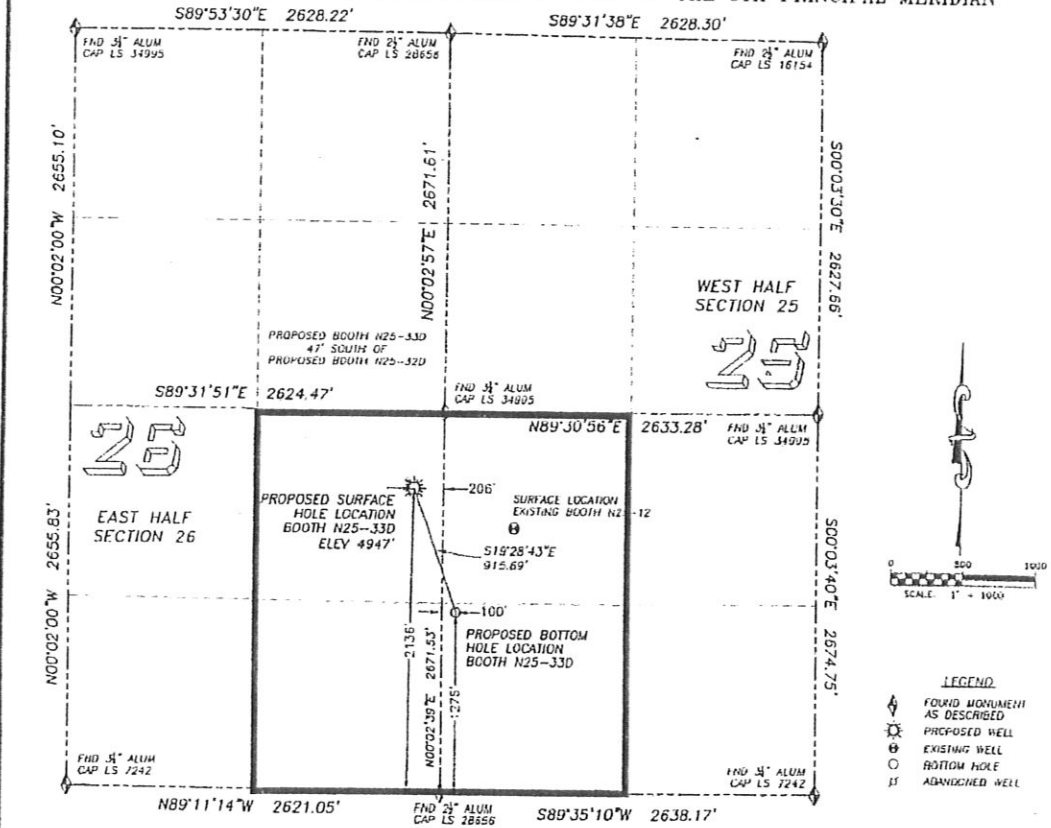

Bottom Hole Located SWSW, Section 25, T5N, R67W, 6th PM

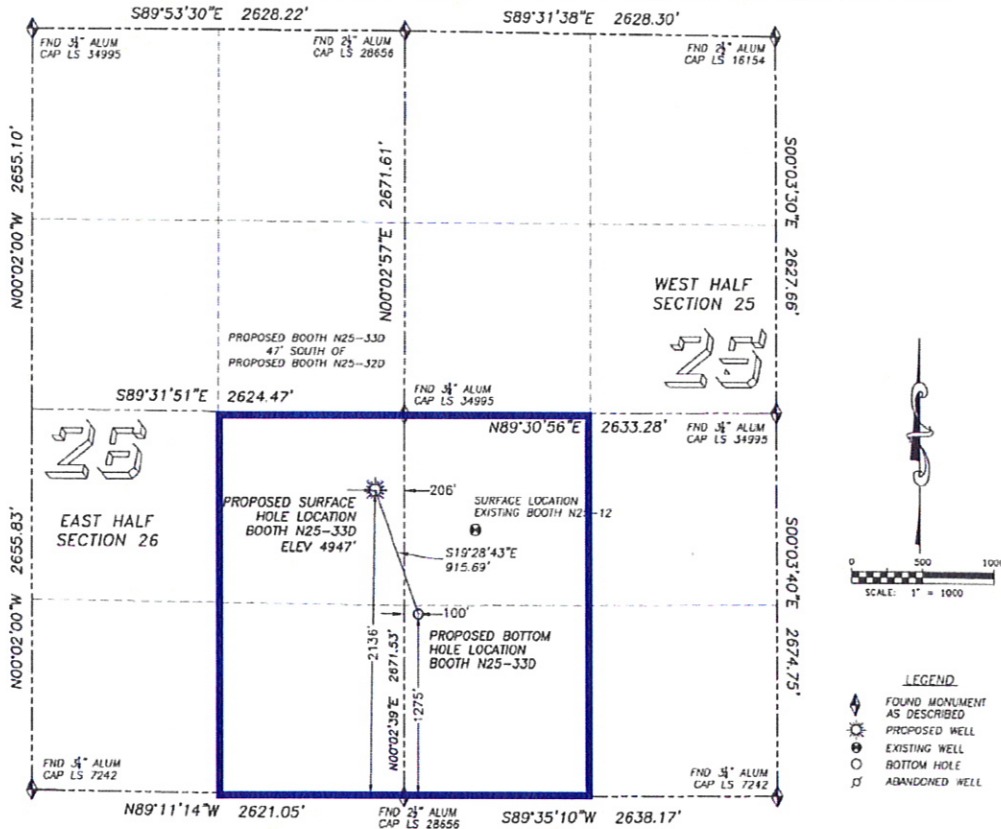

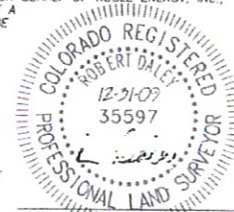
