Julie,

The FAA will handle the safety aspect and may condition lighting or other safety measures. If they condition the "Determination of No Hazard to Air Navigation", then forward a copy of the letter to the COGCC otherwise certify that no conditions were required by the FAA by email.

These permits were submitted as being 155' from the property line and I have worked with Jim Milne our GIS manager trying to confirm that they met the set-back. After considerable review, we agreed that the plat supplied supported the finding that the proposed well locations may be encroaching the set back. If so these locations would be exception locations under rule 603 a(2), so we have questions about the how the distance of 155' was determined and will need further clarification.
