A Sensitive Area Determination has not yet been performed for this location, however, prior to the submittal of a form 15 for the flare pit (special use pit) shown on the plats, a Sensitive Area Determination will be performed. Regardless of the result of the Sensitive Area Determination, Williams will employ the following BMP's to support protection of surface and ground water: Williams will ensure 110% secondary containment for any volume of fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations. Williams will implement best management practices to contain any unintentional release of fluids. Either a lined drilling pit or a closed loop system will be implemented.

**CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL, IF ANY:**

**All representations, stipulations and conditions of approval stated in this Form 2A for this location shall constitute representations, stipulations and conditions of approval for any and all subsequent operations on the location unless this Form 2A is modified by Sundry Notice, Form 4 or an Amended Form 2A.**

No portion of any pit that will be used to hold liquids shall be constructed on fill material, unless the pit and fill slope are designed and certified by a professional engineer, subject to review and approval by the director prior to construction of the pit. The construction and lining of the pit shall be supervised by a professional engineer or their agent. The entire base of the pit must be in cut.

Operator must ensure 110 percent secondary containment for any volume of fluids contained at well site during drilling and completion operations. If fluids are conveyed via pipeline, operator must implement best management practices to contain any unintentional release of fluids.

Reserve pit must be lined or closed loop system must be implemented during drilling.

The moisture content of any drill cuttings in a cuttings pit, trench, or pile shall be as low as practicable to prevent accumulation of liquids greater than de minimis amounts. At the time of closure, the drill cuttings must also meet the applicable standards of table 910-1.

The location is in an area where an intermittent drainage is present and has previously be rerouted; therefore the pad shall be constructed to prevent any stormwater run-on and /or stormwater runoff.

The access road will be constructed as to not allow any sediment to migrate from the access road to the nearby surface water or any drainages leading the surface water.
