Mr. Furr:

The two Applications for Permit to Drill for the referenced wells expired June 10, 2010. Laramie II's interpretation of the new rules assumed these permits were granted a 1 year extension past the June 10, 2010 date since they were approved after the May 1, 2009 COGCC revised rules became effective. Apparently, the permits did not fall within the window of extension the COGCC had established so they did not meet the extension requirements and thus did not qualify for the one year extension.

To honor our commitment to you to drill these wells this summer, Laramie II needs to re-file these two permits and request an expedited approval to keep the drilling rig in operation. In order to do so, the COGCC has requested a signed waiver from you stating you do not oppose the re-files and also waive Rule 305. b. "Notification Requirements", Rule 305. c. "Comment Period", and Rule 306. a. "Surface Owner Consultation". Since we have an agreement covering the surface operations, we are again asking that you waive the notice, comment and consultation requirements.
