Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the remediation documentation submitted in July 2009 for the referenced sites. A variance for SAR and EC is not required given that the upper three feet of the pit were backfilled with clean top soil material. As a reminder, please analyze soil and groundwater samples for all analytes indicated in Table 910-1 of the COGCC Rules. A reduced list of analytes may be granted by COGCC based on process knowledge and site specific conditions. In that case, a sundry notice Form 04 should be submitted to request COGCC approval for the reduced list.

Based on review of this information, COGCC requires no further action at this time.
