Dear Mr. Neslin,

Wellstar Corporation is proposing to enlarge the existing built pad for the above mentioned location. The Bush Draw Federal #10-2 was drilled as a vertical well and Wellstar is planning to bring a drilling rig back and drill a horizontal leg to this well. The pad that was originally built was not large enough to handle the drilling and completion operation equipment (originally approved at 190' x 350'; constructed at an estimated 185'x 324' at 1.38 acres disturbed). Wellstar would like to begin construction to enlarge this pad to an estimated 290' x 355' (an estimated 2.34 acres disturbed) as soon as 9/18/2010.

This request for approval at the soonest possible date accompanies the form 2A that was submitted on 8/26/10 and deemed complete for review on 8/27/10. The BLM is both surface and mineral owner; they were notified of the pad expansion by sundry and approved the proposed pad expansion on 7/13/10 (included in the form 2A attachments).

This letter also includes waivers from the Local Government Designee of Jackson County and the Operator, Wellstar Corporation, showing they have read and understood the Notice of Decision requirements (Rule 304.d(1) & (2)) pertaining to the Oil and Gas Location Assessment, Form 2A, that allows for ten (10) days after the issuance of the decision by the Commission Director, to object to the decision and request a hearing before the Commission pursuant to Rule 503.b on said land and both are waiving any and all requirements set forth by the COGCC.
