Dear Mr. Neslin:

Wexpro Company is requesting a variance to Rule 603. a. (1), which requires the wellhead to be one hundred fifty (150) feet or one and one-half (1-1/2) times the height of the derrick from any public road. In the case of the above referenced well the derrick height from the ground is 180' and would require the proposed drill hole be 270' from County Road 75P. The surveyed footage is 185' from the drill hole to County Road 75P.

The well was originally proposed north of the current location, but due archeological discoveries in that area and to the east, the location was staked in its present location to avoid any possible impact to the archeological features.

Wexpro Company contacted Moffat County Road and Bridge Department and has agreed to place signs to detour any traffic, using an alternate route, around County Road 75P during the drilling phase of the wells located on this pad.

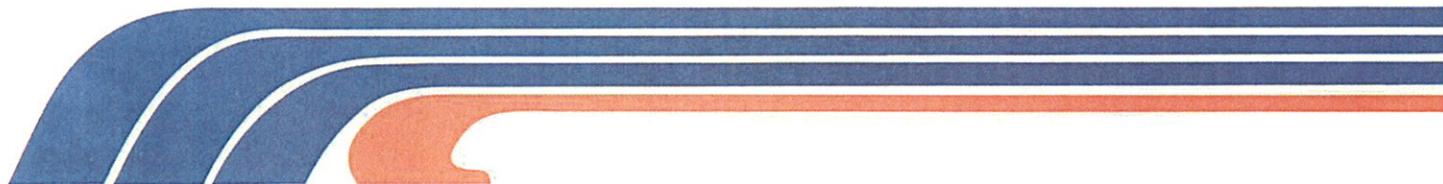
