Dear Mr. Neslin,

Orr Energy, LLC, respectfully requests your consent to drill the Hall 25- 33D, located 716 feet from the South Line and 1802 feet from the East Line and the Hall 25-34 located 716 feet from the South line and 1782 feet from the East line in the SW/SE of Section 25 T6N R67W. An existing surface well location, Long #1 (SW/SE of section 25, 6N R67W) will be located 225 feet from Hall 25-33D and 235 feet from the Hall 25-34 well locations. COGCC Rule 318.A.c. (2) requires a well to be within 50 feet of a current well (twinning) unless the surface owner approves of the placement of the proposed location.
