Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation rule 603a(2) stipulates, "A well shall be a minimum distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet from a surface property line".


We are proposing to drill a coalbed methane gas well in T33S-R67W, Section 10: SW/4SW/4, Las Animas County, Colorado. Available tax assessor's records indicate you are the surface owner of the lands in T33S-R67W, Section 10: Timber Ridge filing Tract 22. In this case, the well site is inside of the 150' minimum distance.
