
We are in receipt of your letter dated December 29, 2010 regarding the above-referenced oil and gas well located in Washington County, Colorado.

Your letter requests that additional monitoring information be submitted by January 31, 2011. We are in the process of completing the site investigation and obtaining the additional information. However, we will require more time to complete the assessment and submit the data. Therefore, we request a short extension of up to March 31, 2011 to submit the information. This short extension should provide sufficient time to collect the additional samples, have the samples analyzed and prepare the site report. We anticipate obtaining the produced water sample by the end of the month. As requested, we will provide oral notice at least three days prior to collecting the sample.

Fritzler Resources, Inc. ("Fritzler") does not agree with the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commissions' interpretation as to applicability of the closure or lining requirements associated with the produced water and skim pits. Fritzler believes that the regulations referenced in your letter and NOAV are not applicable to facilities in Washington County. Nevertheless and without any admission of liability, Fritzler is evaluating its options including potential closure of the skim pit. The short extension will also allow Fritzler to fully evaluate its options to better respond to the NOAV and COGCC's concerns.

Fritzler appreciates its good working relationship with the COGCC. Please let me know if the COGCC will agree to the short extension. We look forward to working with COGCC to amicably resolve any issues raised in the NOAV and your letter.
