Rio Blanco County Area, Colorado

## 70 Redcreek-Rentsac complex, 5 to 30 percent slopes

### Setting

Elevation: 6000 to 7400 feet

Redcreek and similar soils: 60 percent

Parent material: Eolian deposits and/or residuum weathered from sandstone

Drainage class: Well drained  
Capacity of the most limiting layer to transmit water (Ksat): Moderately low or moderately high (0.06 to 0.20 in/hr)

Calcium carbonate maximum: 10 percent  
Gypsum maximum: 0 percent  
Available water capacity: Very low (about 1.7 inches)
