Hi John:

Thanks again for the extension of time to follow-up on the site plan for the Gebauer No. 1. We plan on taking additional water samples from the production pits next Monday--February 28. We anticipate sampling in the mid-morning--around 10:00 am or so. If possible, we are also going to re-sample the upgradient/downgradient groundwater in the vicinity of the production pits as well as take additional surface water samples and/or water samples from the stock tanks in the area if they are active.

Attached for your convenience is a copy of the table with the background water quality results from the previous sampling. We have updated the table to include the results of the production pit water sample taken earlier this year. The table also includes the elevations and approximate depth to groundwater. Groundwater in the area is over 20 feet bgs. As you will note, the production pit water is of comparable quality to the groundwater in the vicinity of the well. It remains Fritzler's position that seepage, if any, from the production pits cannot adversely impact groundwater quality.

Please let me know if you will be taking split samples next Monday. Once we get the results of the second round of sampling, we will submit a site plan for the Gebauer No. 1 production pits.
