Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation rule 603a(2) stipulates, "A well shall be a minimum distance of one hundred fifty feet from a surface property line."

We are proposing to drill a coalbed methane gas well in T32S-R67W, Section 36: SE/4NW/4, Las Animas County, Colorado. Available tax assessor's records indicate that you are the surface owner of the lands in T32S-R67W, Sec. 36: SW/4, E/2NE/4. In this case the well site is inside of the 150' minimum distance.
