Erin,

Per our conversation yesterday, the COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A oil and gas location assessment for the EATON FIELD 2 well pad in the SESW Sec30 T7N R65W, Weld County, and requests the following changes to the Form 2A:

- 1) Facilities:** The multi-well tank battery that serves the Eaton Field 1 pad and the Easton Field 2 pad was already constructed at a location immediately adjacent the proposed Eaton Field 2 pad. Therefore, please provide a revised facilities list for the Eaton Field 2 pad that includes all production equipment at the location.
- 2) Location Drawing:** Since the proposed oil and gas location includes the tank battery in addition to the well pad, please revise the Location Drawing to show all improvements within 400 feet of the revised location.
- 3) Best Management Practices:** The original pad location was located approximately 2500 feet west of the neighborhood, and now is located approximately 800 feet from the neighborhood. In addition to the BMPs attached with the Form 2A submittal, does Ranchers Exploration have proposed BMPs developed to address the following?
  - 1:** noise mitigation for the residents east-northeast of the proposed location (BMPs can include schedule adjustments, mufflers, rig orientation, sound walls, etc. or other measures Ranchers deems appropriate based on their knowledge of the site and their equipment)

**2:** glare and nuisance light mitigation the residents east-northeast of the proposed location (directional lighting, shrouds, or other measures Ranchers deems appropriate)
