Todd,

Thank you for looking for additional records on this older spill report. The spill was reported as being 5 bbl of water, and review of aerial photos indicate that there was no area of stressed vegetation in the farm field one year later. COGCC therefore requires no further action at this time in regard to the release at the subject location. However, should future conditions at the site indicate contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if ground water is found to be significantly impacted, then further investigation and/or remediation activities may be required at the site.

The release (SPILL #1981717) has been changed to closed status in the Colorado Oil & Gas Information System. Please retain a copy of this email as verification of COGCC concurrence with the closure request.
