Dear Mr. Neslin:

In accordance with Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC") Rule 318.c and 502.b, Quicksilver Resources Inc. ("QRI") hereby requests a variance to the unit boundary line setback of 900' as set forth in Order 274-1 for the Weber 32-4 Well. The current Lessor underlying the 40 acre quarter/quarter section above and the offset 80 acres (S2NW) is the United States Department of the Interior Bureau of Land Management ("BLM"). Both tracts are governed by COC-64881, which QRI is the current Lessee (copy attached). QRI has filed its permit for this well with the BLM and has had several onsite meetings. There has been no objection to our current location. Further, QRI is unable to move this location eastward due to home sites and terrain issues in the vicinity (see aerial plat attached).
