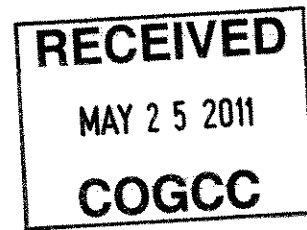

EOG Resources, Inc. (EOG) plans to drill the Greasewood 08-18H well (the "well") at the referenced location which is more specifically described as 501' FNL and 2413' FEL, which is outside the drilling window prescribed in Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC") Rule 318A.a.(1).

By signing this letter, you hereby grant your consent to EOG to locate the well outside of a GWA window as defined in COGCC Rule 318A.a and waive the directional drilling requirement under Rule 318A.e.

EOG hereby agrees that it will not drill the well until you, as the Surface Owner, and EOG have entered into a surface use agreement and the consideration has been paid by EOG prior to building the location and associated roads, if necessary.
