Hi John:

Attached please find a Form 27 and supporting documentation for the subject site located in the SESW Section 7 – T6N – R64W. A Form 19 was submitted to the COGCC on November 30, 2010 (Spill # 2522940). Soil and groundwater were impacted from a dumphine release. Approximately 1,000 CY of impacted soil, from two excavations, and 2,964 barrels of impacted groundwater were removed from the site and transported to licensed disposal facilities. Five groundwater monitoring wells were installed in April 2011 and groundwater samples were subsequently collected. The initial groundwater analytical results indicate groundwater is compliance with CDPHE Regulation 41 Groundwater Standards. PDC will continue to monitor groundwater concentrations until four consecutive quarters of groundwater concentrations are compliant with Regulation 41 standards.
