Paul,

The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400184516) for the Trumpet fish 22-31 location, located in Lot 1 Sec 31 T19S R69W Fremont County, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

1. Multi-well plan: Due to two well being placed on the pad the COGCC requires that a multi well plan be provided. The plan should show both the well head location and bottom hole location. Further information regarding multi well plans can be found in COGCC rule 303.d.3.I.
2. COAS: The location has a COA from the initial 2A that will remain in effect. The COA for the location is as follows:
 - Due to the likely hood of oil being received in the pit and exceeding 10,000 ppm TPH an approved Pit Permit (Form 15) will be required prior to pit construction. The form 15 shall include a pit management plan.
