Hi John,  
Our ongoing activities on the Christiansen lease include the excavation of contaminated soil from the roads and tank battery and placement on plastic. This was completed 7/28/11. From field estimates, there appears to be a couple of thousand cubic yards. We are still waiting on landfill approval for disposal of the soil in nearby counties.

The skim pit bypass system is getting final plumbing installed. While we have been waiting on the bypass, we have been injecting all but a minor amount of produced water. The remaining water has been discharged into the earth skim pit and pumped back into the treatment system to flush some of the oil from the pit banks.

I will update you on the final disposition of the soil once that determination has been made.
