EOG Resources, Inc. (EOG) plans to drill the Greasewood 5-09H well (the "well") at the referenced location which is more specifically described as 501' FNL and 401' FWL, which is outside the drilling window prescribed in Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("COGCC") Rule 318A.a.(1).

By signing this letter, you hereby grant your consent to EOG to locate the well outside of a GWA window as defined in COGCC Rule 318A.a and waive the directional drilling requirement under Rule 318A.e.
