Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the Notice of Completion Report submitted by HRL Compliance Solutions Inc. for Williams on July, 2011 for the referenced site. Consideration was given to background arsenic concentrations. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.

We understand that the above referenced pits will not be backfilled and reclaimed because they will be reused for further drilling operations. Final pit closure and reclamation will be required to comply with COGCC Rules, series 900 and 1000.

The remediation projects have been closed in the COGCC database with the respective Form 27As. If you require any additional information, please call me at (970) 625-2497.
