Petroleum Development Corporation doing business as PDC Energy ("PDC") hereby certifies to the Director that PDC owns all minerals in the proposed 320 acre wellbore spacing unit in the N2 of Section 6, Township 6N, Range 64W; therefore, no 20-day notice is needed to owners in the proposed wellbore spacing unit. This horizontal well location crosses existing unit boundaries and requires the formation of the proposed unit. PDC hereby requests the Director to approve the well.

Please see the attached spacing unit map which certifies that the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6 will have no more than eight (8) bottom-hole locations in each governmental 160 acre unit producing from the Niobrara formation.

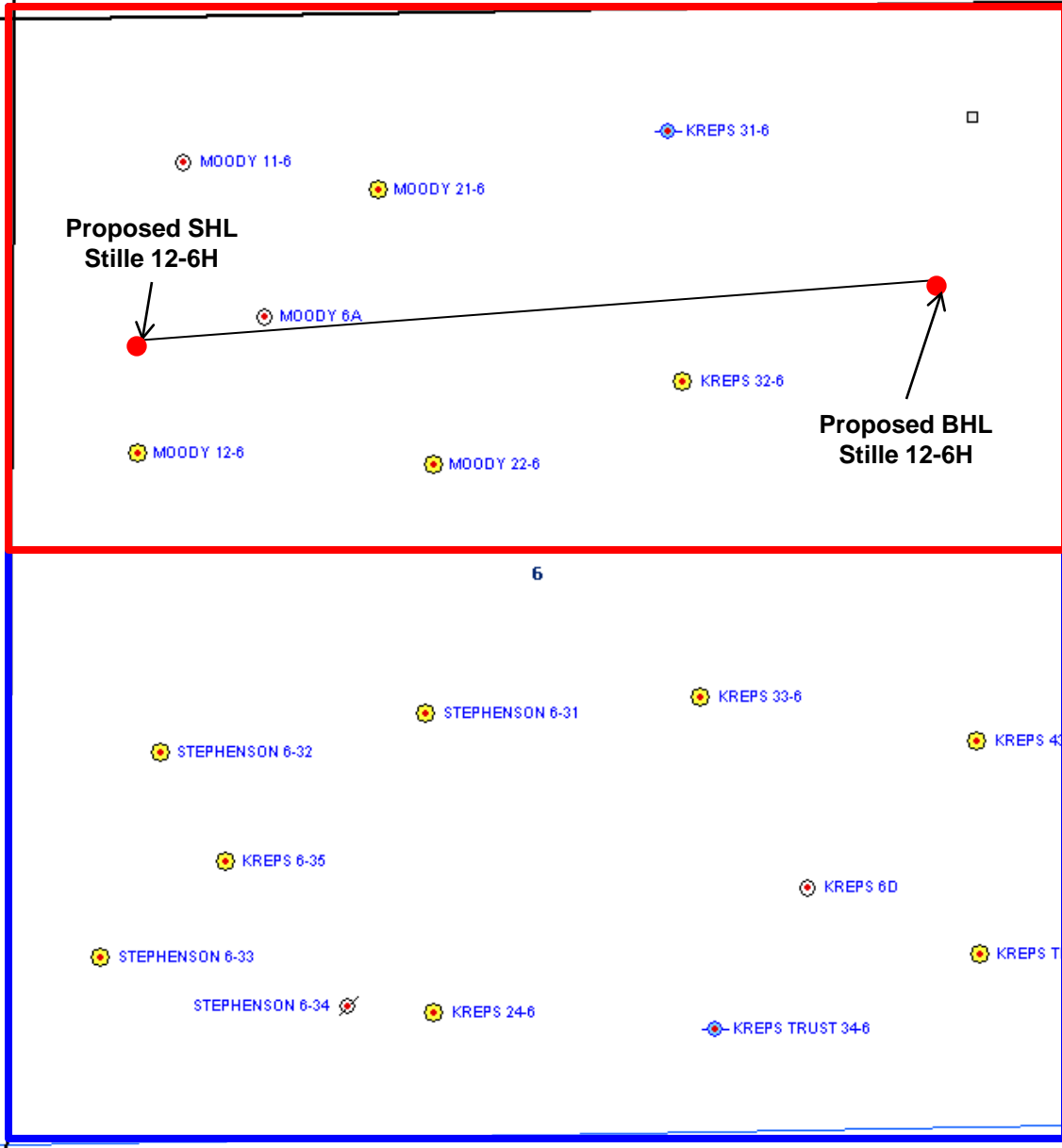
