Dear Mr. Will:

I am writing to follow up on our conversation of today wherein you advised me that your client, Nonsuch Natural Gas, Inc. ("Nonsuch"), was considering whether to comply with or protest the Commission's August 15, 2011 Cease and Desist Order ("Order"). Nonsuch is currently in violation of Paragraph 4 of the Order, which required Nonsuch to commence work on the work plan by no later than September 6, 2011. As of September 8, the work has not begun.

Time is of the essence because the 2011 construction window is rapidly coming to a close. The Commission demands that, by the close of business on Friday, September 9, 2011, Nonsuch shall either (1) commence work under the work plan, or (2) file a protest to the Order so that we can place the same on the Commission's hearing docket for September 19, 2011. In the event Nonsuch takes neither of these actions, I have instructed the Attorney General to seek appropriate relief pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-121(5)(c) to enjoin Nonsuch's operations. Further, the Commission reserves its rights to issue appropriate emergency orders pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-108(3) & 121(6) to suspend and or revoke Nonsuch's permits.
