Provide a detailed description of the accident, problem, and cause (equipment failure, human error, etc.):

A contracted drilling consultant was standing on the midrail of a handrail to disconnect the winchline from the flowline following a rig skid when he slipped and fell 14' to ground. He injured his head, ribs, hip, and bruised a lung from the fall. Due to the injuries, Flight for Life from St. Mary's Hospital in Grand Junction was called and flew the injured consultant to Ashley Valley Regional Medical Center in Vernal, Utah where he was hospitalized overnight. His injuries include sutures to close a laceration on his head, cracked ribs, slight concussion, and a bruised lung and hip. He is expected to be released from the hospital later today. The incident occurred at 7:00 PM on October 4, 2011. Shaun Kellerby and Mike Longworth with the COGCC were notified of the incident by e-mail at 8:40 AM on October 5, 2011.
