The COGCC is reviewing the Form 2A (#400115357) for the OMIMEX Petroleum Bledsoe Federal 12-20-5-44 location, located in the NWSW Sec 20 T5N R44W Yuma County, Colorado. The COGCC requests the following changes regarding the data submitted on or attached to the Form 2A prior to passing the Oil and Gas Location Assessment (OGLA).

Depth to Groundwater

Reviews of water wells in the area surrounding the Bledsoe Federal 12-20-5-44 location indicate the water level is approximately 89 feet (water well permit #31513) not 1993 as stated on the form 2A.

- The 2A should be amended to state the water level is 89 feet.

Distance to nearest well

Reviews of attached location drawing and location photos indicate that there is a windmill used to water stock located approximately 520 feet south East of the location. The distance to nearest well should be changed to 520 feet to reflect the presence of the windmill/well.
