Krista, Aleta,

I have reviewed the Herring Draw 1-33 well site and have the following recommendations for BMPs. The site is located in elk winter range and mule deer critical winter range.

Wildlife concern – Mapped elk winter range, mule deer critical winter range
CDOW recommendations and concerns

- 1) Shell will make a good faith effort to finish drilling at this location outside of the period between December 1 and April 15.
- 2) Shell agrees that if future reentry to this well site, if applicable, will occur outside of the period between December 1 and April 15.
- 3) Interim and final reclamation will match existing vegetation.
- 4) Avoid aggressive non-native grasses and shrubs in mule deer and elk habitat restoration.
- 5) Shell will include a weed management plan and implement the plan as part of reclamation.
- 6) Conduct post-development well site visitations between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and reduce well site visitations between December 1 and April 15 in mule deer and elk winter range.
- 7) Gate single-purpose roads and restrict general public access to reduce traffic disruptions to wildlife - consistent with the surface owner's goals.

Since I did not attend the on-site I am not sure what the access route will be. If possible please use any existing 2 track or other existing road or semi road to minimize vegetation disturbance, soil disturbance and potential access to the property.
