Please let this letter serve as a request for the omission of open hole logs. There are open hole logs within the quarter section. The COGCC has acknowledged that a cement bond log will be accepted in lieu of open hole logs when sufficient nearby wells provide adequate open hole log data as long as EnCana logs up to above the surface casing. All cement bond logs going forward will be logged above the depth of the surface casing shoe to satisfy the state's request. EnCana will submit open hole logs on every well when they are run. The Form 5 will list all open hole logs run, or if none were run it will be clearly stated on the Form 5.
