Dana,

Attached is a copy of a diagram showing approximate soil sample locations with the summary of analytical results for the samples I collected from the Cook tank battery on January 19th. As you can see, the results greatly exceeded the 500 mg/Kg Table 910-1 standard for TPH in soil. These were collected after you submitted the disposal documentation and reported that everything had been cleaned up. Since that time you've reported that everything has been excavated and is pending disposal. I would suggest collecting a minimum of three soil samples in similar locations to verify that all of the contaminated soil was removed from the treater release and historic impacts.

I still haven't received the topo with the spill location. It might seem like a technicality since we know where the spill was, but it would be helpful to have it attached to the spill report for future reference as required by rule. The COGCC map layer has the topo's for NE Colorado. You can simply pull those up, copy the topo to a pdf or other file to create the diagram. Please submit that when you get a chance with a reference to Spill #2221914. If you've already mailed it to the office, then disregard.
