The field road showing on the aerial at the Weld County Assessor's Office shows a well travel field road along the south boundary of Section 30, T6N-R67W. According to Partick McMeekin, the Development Director for this property. This field road was the old mining haul road for hauling agate out of the lake bed. Patrick said they haven't used this road in one and one-half years. The aerial for this area were taken in 2008. The field road is now growing native grasses and weeds.

The entrance to the SW/corner of Sec. 30 is locked all the time. The entrance to the SE/corner of Sec. 30 is open during the day and locked at night. I have attached a plat of the future plans for this area. There are no future plans for a road along the south boundary of Section 30.
