I have done a review of the Encana Albertson G15 7 101 well pad location. The pad is located in elk winter concentration area as depicted on the COGCC web mapping site.

Albertson G15 7 101 Well pad BMPs

Restrict post development, daily well site visitations to the hours between 9:00am and 4:00pm and between 12:01am and 4:00am for the winter period between January 1 and April 15 for elk winter range excluding safety or fluid management visits.

Establish company guidelines to minimize wildlife mortality from vehicle collisions on roads.

Avoid aggressive non-native grasses and shrubs in mule deer and elk habitat restoration.

Encana intends to use a seed mix during interim reclamation that's wildlife friendly.

If the BMPs are acceptable I will make the recommendations today before the end of business.
