NEI's proposed wellbore spacing unit consists of the SW/4NW/4, NW/4SW/4 of Sec 19, T4N, R65W, & SE/4NE/4, NE/4SE/4 of Sec 24, T4N, R66W, creating a 160-acre wellbore spacing unit. 


