When breaking the connection on a stand of drill pipe the contractor pinched his right hand little finger between the two sets of tongs. The impact caused a fracture to the bone in the finger and sutures were required to close the laceration. The contractor returned to work the same day on modified duty status. The incident occurred at 5:50 AM on March 20, 2012. Shaun Kellerby with the COGCC was notified of the incident by e-mail at 3:55 PM on March 20, 2012.
