Arthur- I wanted to give you notice that Hilcorp intends to build lined fresh water pits for their fracking operations in El Paso County for the Myers 21-06CH & State of Colorado 24-33BH well locations. These pits will only be utilized for fresh water and not for frack flow back. All frack flow back will be contained within tanks.

The dimension of the fresh water pits for the Myers 21-06CH & State of Colorado 24-33BH will be 200' x 100' x 15' for an approximate volume of 50,000 barrels. Signs will be posted at the pit for "Fresh Water Use Only."

I will email you a revised "Proposed Pad Layout" by the end of the week.
