Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) staff has reviewed the documentation submitted by Chevron in April 2012 for the referenced sites. Based on review of data presented, it appears that no further action is necessary at this time at this site. However, should future conditions at the site be discovered of contaminant concentrations in soils exceeding COGCC standards or if groundwater is found to be significantly impacted, COGCC may require that further investigation and/or remediation be conducted.
