DOW	<p>This site is located in the Roan Creek Drainage on Encana property. Plot center is about 240 from Roan Creek, falls within a Mule Deer Critical Winter Range, and is 3 miles downstream from a Restricted Surface Cutthroat Trout Habitat. It does not fall within an existing WMP. Since there will be minimal surface disturbance, and the site is to be used for fresh water holding tanks, there are no hazardous material concerns. In addition to the BMPs provided by Encana, the CPW would like it if the contractor could minimize traffic to the site during the Mule Deer Critical winter range; between 1 December and 15 April.</p> <p>The CPW requests that if the water tanks are filled with water from other than Roan Creek, that steps be taken to prevent the potential threat of contaminating Roan Creek with Aquatic Nuisance Species (ANS) should a tank leak or rupture occur.
